Annual Fergie x Tree Top Kerry (Bitch - January 25) - Reserve €3,800 (Choice of 2 bitches)

Tree Top Kerry (Adios Alonso-Tanyard Kerry) impressed in winning All Age Bitch Stakes at Limerick City, Millstreet, and South Clare. Annual Fergie needs no introduction. A winner of Corn na Feile at Abbeyfeale, he went on to win the 2022 BOYLE Sports Derby. Bred by William Lonergan, this lady has produced some really classy sorts, which include Tree Top Tyson, a beaten semi-finalist in the 2023 BOYLE Sports Derby and a beaten finalist in the Callaway Kennels Kevin Smith Champion Stakes back in 2024. Two seriously well-bred bitches.



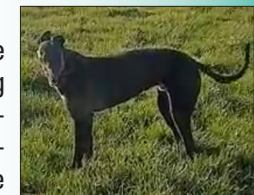
Watchman x Ryco City (Dog - April 25) - Reserve €4,000

Ryco City (Ballymac Best-Try Colour) won the Reserve Oaks Trial Stake in Freshford in 2021, and she was a beaten finalist at Borris In Ossory in the Oaks Trial Stake. After that owner James Coss kept her for breeding, which was the reason he bought her in the first place, with dam Try Colour having thrown some very good winners including Savage Love, dam of this year's Derby qualifiers Good Energy and Magical Titan, a leading fancy. Her line goes back to the Moat breeding and she's an excellent outcross. Sire Watchman was a very special dog, winning the Irish Cup in both 2018 and 2019.



Blame the Game x Cloncunny Wonder (Dog - May 25) Reserve €4,750

Cloncunny Wonder (Newinn Wonder-Ardera Sansa) ran-up the Patsy Byrne Select Bitch Stake at Co Limerick in 2022, as a puppy, and the following season, ran out a brilliant winner of All-Age Bitch Stakes at both Castleisland and Lixnaw. Blame The Game had massive speed clocking some top-class times on the track and is now a proven dual-purpose sire following the success of his son Gone To Strand in the 2025 Boylesports Coursing Derby. Bred by Jim Scully, in her most recent litter, Cloncunny Wonder has produced Butterfield, a superb winner of the Corn na Féile Oaks at Abbeyfeale and a leading fancy for the Horse & Jockey Hotel Oaks; and Galevalley Zebo, winner of the Dungarvan Derby Trial Stake. This pup could be anything.



Foxhollow Adios x Mulcahys Peak (Dog - April 25) - Reserve €5,750

Mulcahys Peak (Timber House-Ballymac Town) has bred many top-class sorts. Bred by Seán Collins, in her opening litter, she produced a phenomenal seven trial stake winners, which included A Noble Friend, a semi-finalist in the BOYLE Sports Derby. Also in the litter was Boherlode Bomber, a winner of the Dick Fitzgerald Purse. In her next litter, she produced Revello Del Toro, winner of the 2025 Horse & Jockey Hotel Irish Oaks and Coursing Bitch of the Year. And from her 2024 litter, Hunters Dream and Estocada have qualified for the Derby. Breeding at its very best
